1. Mo Shirazi – When the senate is approving budgets, please think about yourself too while approving money for the students. I want everybody here to understand that Justin Chou is not officially the vice chair but he is the best President of Campus Relations that I could think of after myself.
2. Web Hamilton – I want to thank DASB for their support for this coming year. We will be very happy if we get the \$5,000 for our program because without it we won't be able to operate the program for 3 quarters next year. We are trying to get donations from private donors. We want to invite all DASB members to a party that we are going to have and I will send out emails for that later.
3. Alex Giardiano – It has come to my attention that in the last week there has been a lot of misinformation and I would like to clarify that. First, if the DASB has to cut the honors budget there will be no funding for this program. I will have to turn to administration to find funds but that won't be possible. This program's future rests in your hands. The budget was cut to zero and I have 327 students in the program. The faculty emailed me saying how disappointed they are. We will cut short 150 students that worked with us last year. I request \$22,000 like every year. Last year we received \$10,000 from the college, which was not enough for us to function.
4. Jason Damjanovic- I want to thank you for your support. The money you gave us allowed us to have tournaments. The kids really appreciate your support and I want to thank you for your continued support. I get a lot of students from a lot of classes. The money you give us is used completely for the students. It pays for the travelling, food, equipment, hotel expenses etc. I greatly appreciate it
5. Dawnis Guevara – I'm the volleyball coach and I want to thank everyone here for supporting us in the past. Without your support, we could never do all this. For our sport, we had an increase in the number of tournaments to stay at a competitive edge with other teams in state.
6. Jan Rindfleisch – I want to read with you, some of our end of the year reports and I want to put the reports here and the press releases for everyone so you can get more information. We need around \$10,000 this year so that we could build a year round program and get extra funds from other places. Thank you very much.
7. Cain Ramirez–If you cut the music department you are restricting yourself. First, my composition class was cut which was needed to transfer. In the same way, they would keep on cutting other arts classes too. We are cutting few dollars on extra curricular activities.

8. Kulwant Singh – I am the director of athletics and I gave the group a snapshot of our success; specially our academic success. This Monday, Dr.Murphy received a letter from the government and we were notified that we have 3 scholar teams for entire team of California. They have all GPAs of teams and they compare them to the athlete GPAs of other schools. We are continuing our strong tradition of academics as well as our athletics. About badminton, it's the newest women's program in the state. I would like to request for an additional \$1,000 for that.
9. Herminio Hernando – I want to thank the DASB for the funding to help us tutor math. For many of our students, it is math that prevents them from graduating and moving on. MPS has grown from 2 sections and now we have 5 sections. We are hoping to expand further since we have had students who repeated the same math course 3 to4 times. Thank u for the money to hire tutors. If there is a possibility of an increase in funding to help us grow, that would be great.
