and synchronous live meetings

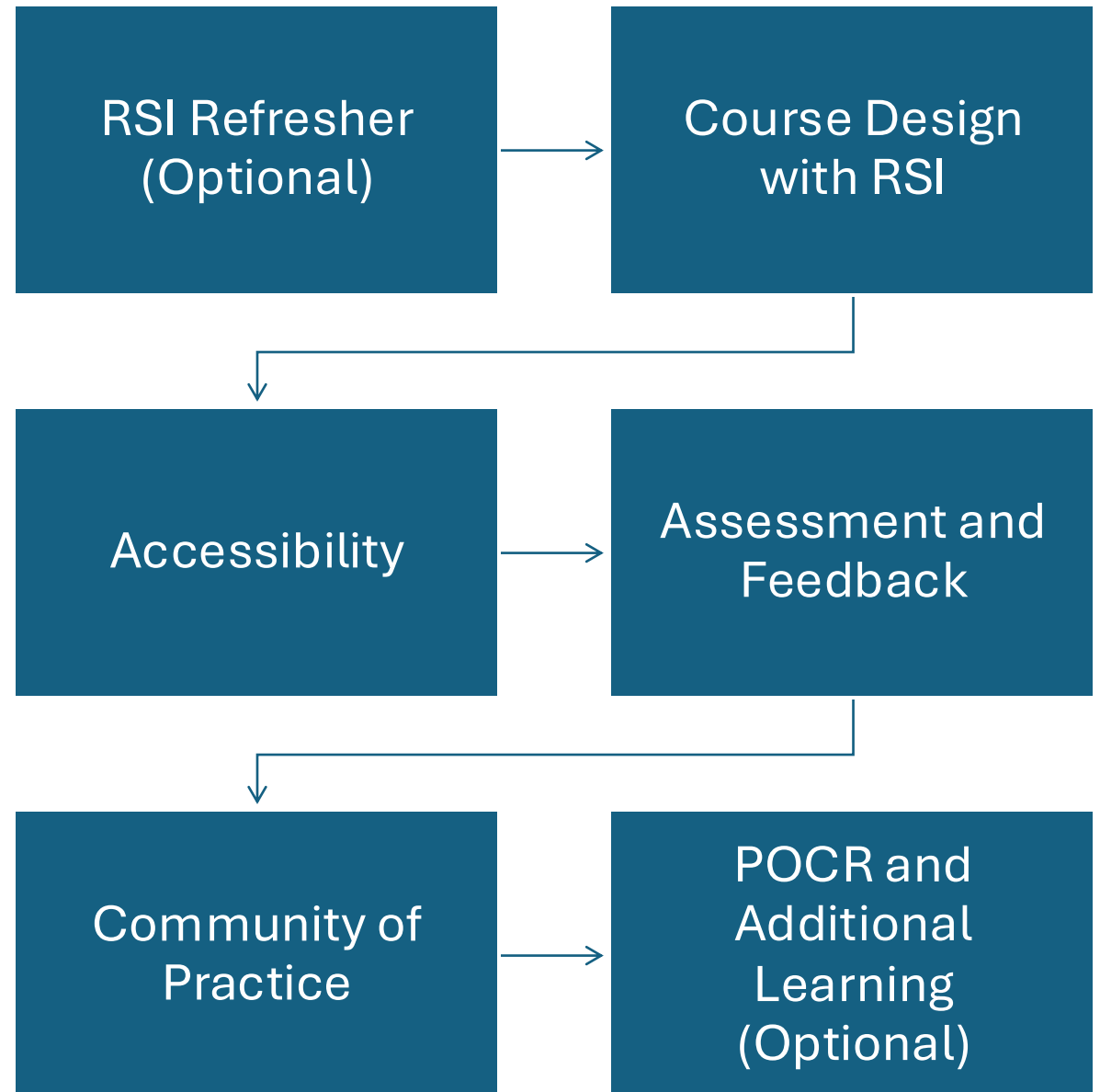
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Faculty will be enrolled in a Canvas

# Course Content



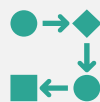
# Fall Peer Cohort

# Winter Peer Cohort



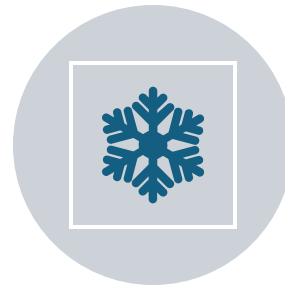
We will run quarter long and 4-week intensive versions of cohorts
