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***Equipment vs Lottery***

College Services	Expenditures made by districts for equipment, improvement of sites, building fixtures and service systems, direct purchase, lease-purchased
Lottery	<b>Instructional*</b> items that are consumable such as sports uniforms, or that have a service life of less than one year i.e. lab equipment . Another category: software and computer hardware (depending on cost); software licenses, access to online resource licenses
Instructional Equipment	<b>Instructional*</b> , items over \$200 each, with a life expectancy over 2 years,. These items must be inventoried upon delivery to the District. And they can be repaired.

\*Definition of the term "Instructional": used by teachers and students to access to gain knowledge and increase cognitive development . . .

***Basic Skills***

Basic Skills	All funding must be intended to improve outcomes of students who enter college needing at least one course in ESL or basic skills. Justification will be required. Examples, software and licenses for assessment, counselor, tutors, coordinator, instructional materials, textbooks, professional development.
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
