- ESL AB705 implementation recommendations from CCCCO anticipated in May

No changes to ESL!

- Students have the right to **access transfer level** English and Math courses
- **U.S. high school transcript** data = primary tool for English and math placement
- A **Guided Self-Placement (GSP)** process will be used to assess those without U.S. high school transcripts

Projected number of students with US high school transcripts

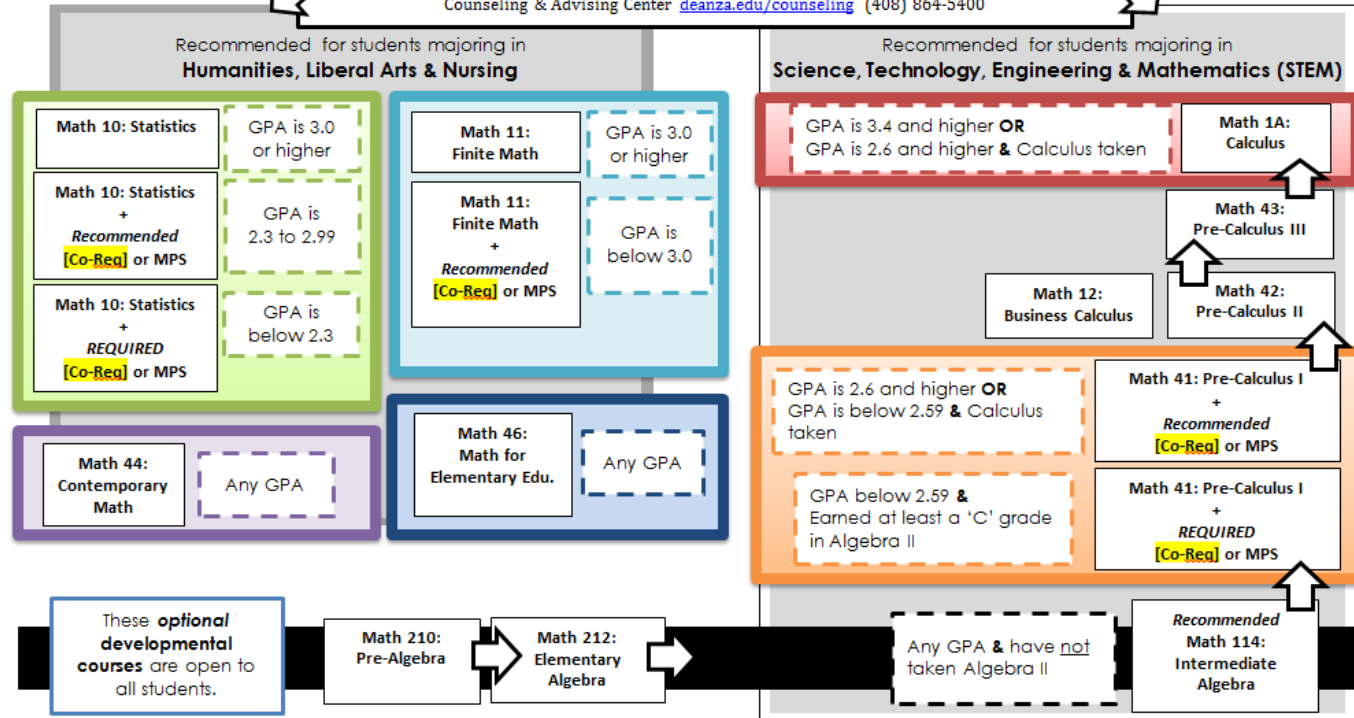

Due to changes in state law, De Anza now assesses **U.S. high school transcripts** for math course placement. Here's the info that we need: your unweighted, total, or cumulative grade point average (GPA is out of a 4.0 scale) & highest level math course taken with grade earned.
Didn't complete at least 9-11th grades in a U.S. high school? You'll be assessed through the Math Guided Self-Placement (GSP) process (*see reverse*).

Are you an English learner? *Unsure if you are ready for English courses?*

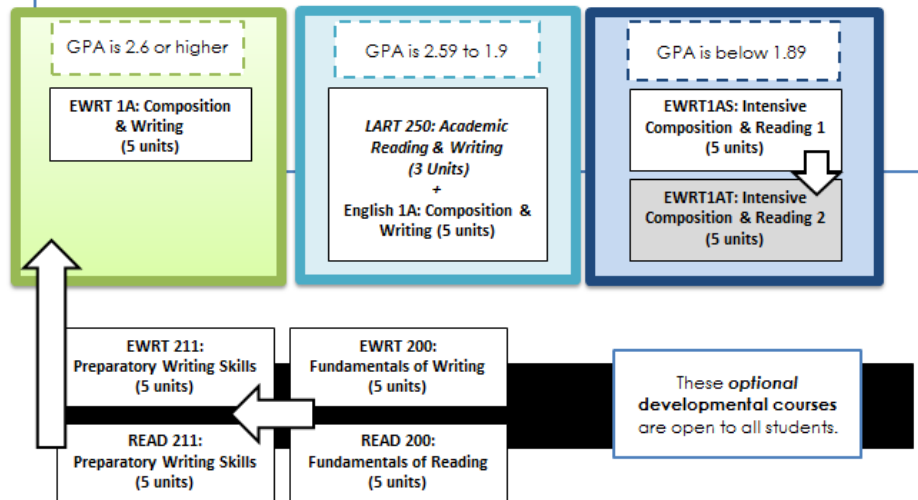
You should take the English as a Second Language (ESL) placement test for ESL course placement.

Are you a native English speaker but didn't complete at least 9-11th grades in a U.S. high school? Or don't know your GPA because you have been out of high school for several years?

You'll be assessed through the English Guided Self-Placement (GSP) process (*see reverse*).

De Anza offers three different course formats which allow students to fulfill the college level English composition requirement.

Students are placed into one of the below courses based on unweighted, total or cumulative grade point average (GPA is out of a 4.0 scale):

AB705 Working Group Recommendations

- Have counselors available/accessible to support students with the GSP process

Ongoing Discussions

- GSP may continue to be a barrier for our non-traditional, first-time college students
 - Unsure of educational goal
 - Unclear pathway to goal/college
- Embedded Counseling Model
 - Granting access to counselor guidance before/ during the GSP process
